

PARENT'S DAY OUT GUIDELINES

The children will be consistently praised for use of appropriate behavior. The following guidelines will be modeled and reinforced.

1. We play safely.
2. We keep our hands and feet to ourselves
3. We are respectful.

PROCEDURE FOR DISCIPLINE

For those children who have difficulty with the appropriate guidelines, they will be spoken to privately. If inappropriate behavior continues, the student will be redirected to a different activity. We feel it is important to discipline children in a way that is positive and patient. The use of physical punishment is Never Permitted.

WINTER WEATHER

When the weather is cold, wet, or snowy, we stay indoors and play indoor games. Some of our indoor games include bowling, (soft fuzzy bowling balls), musical chairs, marching, Simon Says, freeze dance, and many more.
